CONTEXT

Name of Creator(s): Clarke, Barbara (1938-2007).

Biographical History: Barbara Clarke was born in Dublin in 1938. She started dancing at the age of 4 at the Burchill School of Dancing on St Stephen's Green, Dublin, where she studied both ballet and tap. Her first stage appearance was in the Burchill School of Dancing Recital at the Gaiety Theatre in 1943 at the age of five. From the very beginning, she showed exceptional talent and enthusiasm, and steadily built up her skills by undertaking dance and teaching qualifications. As she progressed, she began to help Miss Burchill with the younger classes and continued to participate in the school's regular recitals at the Gaiety Theatre. As there was no full-time work for dancers in Ireland in the 1960s and 1970s, Barbara trained as secretary at Alexandra College, Dublin, and worked in that capacity for a firm of stockbrokers in the city. She dedicated her spare time to dance, both as a performer and a choreographer, and gained countrywide publicity through her appearances in RTÉ's popular programme, *Shall We Dance?* She continued her involvement in the art form until 1992, when a stroke called a halt to her active dancing career.

Immediate Source of Acquisition: The collection was donated by Barbara Clarke's brother, Gordon Clarke, to the National Dance Archive of Ireland on 8 February 2012.

CONTENT AND STRUCTURE

Scope and Content: Photographs, certificates, contracts, and correspondence illustrating Barbara Clarke's development from a child dance enthusiast to an accomplished amateur dancer, and her contribution to the development of dance as a popular art form in Ireland in the mid-twentieth century.

Appraisal, Destruction and Scheduling Information: All records have been retained.

Accruals: Accruals are unlikely.

System of Arrangement: Documents have been divided into three series according to their form, and thereunder arranged chronologically by date.

Photograph album containing programmes of recitals by pupils of Burchill School of Dancing at the Gaiety Theatre, Dublin, with related press cuttings and black and white photographs of Clarke between the ages of 8 and 24. The first images depict Clarke in the garden of her home, posing in costume after each performance. Later images feature Clarke during performances with her fellow dancers, including Ethel Ormston, Albert Regent, and Clarke's dancing partner Barry Drumm. The images relate to performances given in June 1946, June 1948, November 1950, February 1953, May 1956, April 1958, May 1960, and June 1962. Also contained in the album are press cuttings relating to Clarke's first television appearance in December 1961. *Fragile, with several loose items*.

The material includes screen shots, photographs, and press cuttings relating to her appearances with Albert Regent, Rosalie ('Roly') Hodgson, and others in the RTÉ programme *Shall We Dance?* (1961-1963); programmes of recitals by pupils of Burchill School of Dancing and of Jack Cruise Christmas and summer productions with related press cuttings and photographs (1965-1967); press cuttings relating to Eveline Burchill and her School of Dancing (1968); and programmes of performances by the Dublin Ballet Club at Dagg Hall and Cork Municipal School of Music in 1968 and 1970. *Fragile, with some loose items*. The material includes programmes, press cuttings, and photographs of recitals by pupils of Burchill School of Dance and Dublin Ballet Club (1971-1973); costume and props lists; press cuttings relating to Eveline Burchill and her School of Ballet and its former pupils; and programmes of performances choreographed by Clarke, mostly for Dublin Dance Theatre, with related press cuttings and photographs (1974-1982).
