

- English-track programmes at all three Bologna levels;

- 237 courses in English (43.41 per cent of all courses);
- Partnerships with 40 schools with EQUIS accreditation and 39 schools with AACSB accreditation (of which there are 26 schools with both accreditations);
- In 2011/2012, 329 foreign students enrolled at the FELU;
- In 2011/2012, 290 incoming students and 238 outgoing students
- The Ljubljana Summer School 2012 hosted 318 foreign students from 36 countries;
- Two off-site campuses (Macedonia and Kosovo);
- Confucius Institute Ljubljana
- Over EUR 10 million investment in internationalisation in the last five years












Exchange Students Applications

- Nomination period for partner university: 1 March and 1 November
- An e-mail is sent to students with application instructions
- Application deadline for students:
 15 May (first term/ whole year) and 15 November (second term)
- Course registration: June July(first term), November (second term)
- Language requirements: Language certificate with CERF scale or TOEFL
