Brief Introduction of the University	<p>Founded in 1946 and merged at the beginning of 21st Century with other 5 universities, Jilin University has become the biggest university in China. Today, the University enrolls 70,157 full-time students, 25,084 of whom are graduate students and more than 2,000 are international students. 6,624 faculty members including 2,014 full professors have made great contribution to the academic excellence of the University.</p> <p>With the support from the Ministry of Education, especially from “985 Project” and “211 Project” etc., the University has taken it seriously to create a perfect atmosphere for scientific research, educational innovation and talent cultivation.</p> <p>So far, the University has established exchange and cooperation ties with 276 institutions in 39 countries or regions. Aiming to become an internationally renowned research-oriented university, the University offers big options of programs, covering all the 13 academic categories in China: philosophy, economics, law, literature, education, history, science, engineering, agriculture, medicine, management, military science and arts.</p>

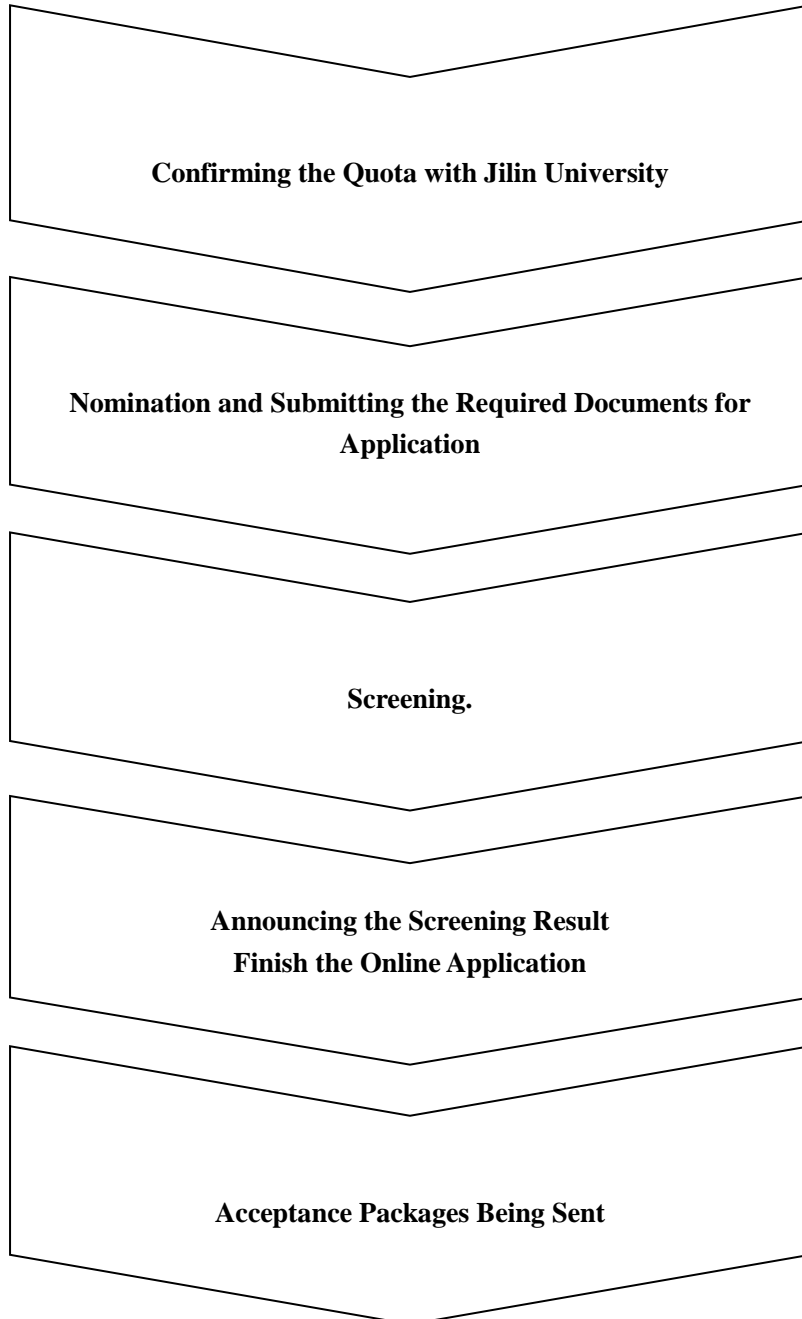

Language Requirements for Exchange Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Programs in Chinese: HSK Level 5 at least. ◆ Programs in English: A valid TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score which is higher than 80 (iBT) or a valid IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score which is higher than 6.0 or equivalent score in other forms of English language tests. ◆ Note: no language requirement for the students who apply for the program of Chinese Language Courses (for none-native speakers).
Free Language Course	We could arrange exchange students to take Chinese language course free of charge according to the timetable of the courses he/she has applied for.

Nomination Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Before the Official nomination, exchange coordinators MUST consult with JLU exchange program manager or officer for your region concerning the number of Student Exchange Program nominees. 2. Once the number of nominees has been confirmed, you may send the scan copy of all the Required Documents for Application and return it to relevant regional manager or officer.
Required Documents for Application	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Nominated Name list; 2. A letter of recommendation from the office responsible for exchange students at home institution; 3. Exchange students application form; 4. Study plan in English or Chinese; 5. Official transcript; 6. Certificate of Enrollment; 7. A copy of passport photo page; 8. Language test certificate.
Screening Procedure	<p>The Office of Global Engagement (OGE) receives applications and reviews that all application requirements have been met. The application packet is then forwarded to the screening committee of each college for assessment. Not all candidates nominated by partner universities are admitted. Some may fail to have an admission if the requirements do not meet the committee's expectation. When the acceptance is confirmed, the OGE notifies the result through the students' home institution. The OGE is not responsible for the selection process and its results since the decision is made by each college.</p>

G. Other Information:

Residence Permit	All international students need a residence permit if staying longer than 6 months in China. It can be obtained under help of JLU staff after arrival.
Health Examination	Exchange students MUST go to an authorized hospital to get one after arrival in China, Please consult the College of International Education about the detailed arrangement after registration.
Insurance	All international students (including exchange students) are required to have a group comprehensive insurance, which includes an Accidental Injury Medical Treatment Insurance & a Hospitalization Medical Insurance when they arrive. Insurance Fee: ¥ 300 -400CNY for 6 months ¥ 600-800 CNY for 12 months

Housing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ On-campus housing Jilin University provides on-campus housing and meals for exchange students. All rooms are double occupancy in principle. ◆ Off-campus housing You may get the information of off-campus housing from the College of International Education, register at the local police station and get approval from the Public Security Organization.
living Expenses	<p>The living expenses (on-campus housing and meals) will be approximately ¥3000CNY per month. Following is a rough estimate of expenses for a single person living in Changchun:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Lunch or dinner at a restaurant ¥50.00 ◆ Public Bus ticket (one way) ¥1.00+ ◆ Taxi ¥6.00+
Average Temperature in Changchun	<p>Changchun has four distinct seasons. Average summer temperature ranges from 20-25°C, highest being some 30°C, the weather is dry and usually air conditioning is not needed in summer. Average winter temperature is about -12 to -16°C, lowest rarely reaches -30°C. but all rooms are well heated. You could enjoy skating and skiing in winter time.</p>

Work Permit	International students (X visa holders) are not allowed to work outside the campus yet.
