French Language Summer School	French Language Summer School: August 2 <sup>nd</sup> to 28 <sup>th</sup> , 2021 (TO BE CONFIRMED) French as a Foreign Language: each Thursday afternoon – 60€/semester
Health insurance requirements and costs	Do you required students to have a health insurance? <b>YES, it's compulsory and free</b> if students out European Union stay more than 3 months <b>OR</b> if students don't have the European card of health insurance. In this case, students <b>MUST</b> register with the 'Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie' ( <a href="#">CPAM-Ameli</a> = Social Security Student) as soon as they have their school certificate at INSA In addition, and if they arrive in France before September 1 <sup>st</sup> , <u>students without the European card of health insurance must subscribe</u> while being in their home country, an International Medical Health Insurance translated into French or English valid until September 1 <sup>st</sup> .
Accommodation	If accepted at INSA Toulouse, students shall receive <b>by email their acceptance letter</b> . Any student accepted at the INSA who wishes an accommodation through the International Office (DRI) must <b>MANDATORLY</b> ask to relint.incoming@insa-toulouse.fr <b>Within the deadline</b> indicated in our email with the acceptance letter and due to the very limited number of accommodations, the International Office (DRI) <b>may book</b> an accommodation with our 2 partners: CROUS and PROMOLOGIS. - CROUS rooms and studios coordinated by SRI: from 300€ to 400€ per month; - PROMOLOGIS studios coordinated by SRI: around 417€ to 480€ per month. <b>Late applications for accommodation will be refused.</b> If students prefer to live somewhere else, <u>they shall book it by themselves</u> . If they ask us, we provide information and a <a href="#">list of accommodations</a> to help students but we recommend that they subscribe to the <a href="#">Toul'box service</a> which help them find accommodation and for the many administrative formalities which are essential on arrival at INSA-Toulouse ("All-in" Package – 200€ in 2020/2021)
