



€26,748 Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences Graduates The average starting salary for UL Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences graduates is €26,748.





Regions of Employment



Global

The greatest percentage of graduates working overseas went to the EU, at 35%. Of those, the largest percentage was in the Education sector, followed by Financial, Insurance & Real Estate, and then Professional, Scientific & Technical. Great Britain took the second largest number, with Education again foremost, followed by Human Health & Social Work, and Accommodation & Food Services.



Ireland

Closer to home, the Mid West took the largest percentage of graduates of AHSS, at 50%. Of those, Wholesale & Retail, Financial, Insurance & Real Estate, and Education were the sectors most represented. The East of the country took the next largest, at 23%. Of those, Financial, Insurance & Real Estate was the sector that featured most, followed by Education, and Professional, Scientific, and Technical.
