Regions of Employment



Global

Internationally, 27 graduates went to Great Britain (38%). Of those, 37% were in the Financial, Insurance and Real Estate sector, and 15% in both Administrative and Support Services and Professional Scientific and Technical. North America took 25%, with Financial Insurance and Real Estate and Professional Scientific and Technical each taking 22%.



Ireland

In Ireland, the Mid West took the largest percentage of Graduates with 41%. Of those, the greatest number went to the Financial, Insurance & Retail sector (33%), followed by Industry (15%). The area with the next highest percentage was in the East, at 36%. Sectors reported there included Financial, Insurance and Real Estate (47%), Professional, Scientific & Technical 10%, and Information & Communication (7%).
