

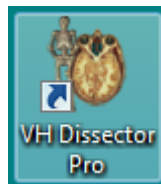
Anatomy E-Learning Resources



The following instructions detail how to access the anatomy e-learning resources:

VH Dissector Pro is available on the PCs in the Anatomy PC lab, GEMS2-029 and on 14 PCs in the PC lab GEMS1-023 (these PCs are labelled to indicate that they have this software installed). These labs are open during building opening hours, i.e. 08.00-22.00 Monday to Friday and 09.00-18.00 Saturday and Sunday.
