

GARDA VETTING - PROVING IDENTITY

Information for Applicants (of Affiliate Organisations)

It is a requirement under the National Vetting Bureau procedures that the applicant provide proof of their identity and proof of their current residence.

The Designated Person/s of the Affiliate Organisations' are required to check/confirm and send copies of the applicant's identity documentation along with this form to ulstaffgardavetting@ul.ie

In order to establish your identity for vetting purposes, an individual must provide documentary proof of each of the following:

- Valid Photographic ID to include name and date of birth.
- Evidence of current address

Please note;

- Evidence of address provided must be dated within 6 months of the date of application.
- The name on the photo ID must match the name on your proof of address.

In order to assist individuals, the below **100 point check** is a personal identification system which may be utilised to verify identity for vetting purposes.
