### What is different? Sulis vs Brightspace

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This document maps the functionality differences between both VLEs, to provide teaching staff with relevant recommendations and further support. It complements the existing article mapping tool functionality <u>Sulis to Brightspace tools | University of Limerick</u>.

The app contains data validation to eliminate the risks of duplicate account creation. Question libraries are stored in the module and are not automatically available to other modules, but can be copied or imported between modules by an instructor who has access to both modules.	Brightspace recommend that all new questions are added in the question library first, this will help keep track of the questions and allow you to import questions into quizzes or to other modules more easily.
