

# Application FAQs

- What documents do I need?
  - You require proof of your English level, your I.D. and your most recent transcript from your current studies.
- Do I need to put 10 modules in the list when I only need to take 5?
  - This list of modules is only used by our registry team for planning purposes, so we ask you enter all the modules requested.
- I don't know my graduation date, what will I put down?
  - We only require an estimate of when you will graduate so if you should finish university 2 years from now in May then enter an approximate date of the relevant month and year.
- What should I enter as my qualifications?
  - Please enter the level of your current level of studies i.e. If you are studying to achieve your bachelor's degree enter bachelors.
- I want to apply for accommodation as soon as possible do I have to wait for my application to be processed?
  - Yes, your application must be processed and accepted before you apply for accommodation because you need your UL student number to apply which will only be sent to you in your "Offer Letter" which is sent when the UL Global office processes your application.
- Can I take modules from any year group?
  - Yes, you can choose modules from any year group.

# Application FAQs Continued

- Do I need to include my learning agreement in my application?
  - No, we do not require your learning agreement at this time.
- I forgot to include one of my documents in the application, what do I do?
  - When we begin processing your application, we will request any missing documents through the online portal. Please wait for this request to send your documents to us.
- I'm not sure my documentation will be acceptable for my application?
  - Please upload your documents as you have them currently, if we require more information, we will request it from you.
- What is required in the transcript?
  - We should be able to see your grades clearly for the modules you have studied previously during your current studies.
- My transcript shows I passed an English language module, does this fulfil the proof of English requirements?
  - No, we require an English language certificate or a letter from your home university stating you have a sufficient level of English for your application to be accepted.
- What is my type of Study?
  - If you will be taking classes in UL you will be studying Academic Modules
