<b>Do you offer courses conducted in English?</b>	All courses taught in English with the exception of foreign language classes (Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Russian, Spanish, Latin)

<b>Transcripts and transcripts sending dates</b>	<p>Official Transcripts will be sent within one month of final examinations directly to the exchange coordinator at the student's home institution.</p>
<b>Arrival and Orientation</b>	
<b>Is airport pick-up service available?</b>	<p>Yes, but only on the recommended arrival date. See Exchange Student Calendar above.</p>
<b>Orientation sessions for incoming students</b>	<p>Exchange orientation will be held on Monday the week before classes start. It is immediately followed by International Student orientation, held on Tuesday – Thursday the week before classes start.</p>
<b>Cultural adjustment programs?</b>	<p>Students are automatically assigned a Cultural Mentor (a current CSU student) who works with them and helps them adjust to life in the United States throughout the semester, <a href="http://iss.colostate.edu/cultural_mentor/">http://iss.colostate.edu/cultural_mentor/</a>. The Cultural Mentor is encouraged to reach out to their mentee prior to the start of the semester. Students have the opportunity to meet each other during Orientation Week.</p>

<b>When and what kind of visa do the students need to obtain? The cost?</b>	<p>J1 – Visiting Student Visa</p> <p>The students will receive a DS 2019 form and instructions for applying for their visa upon acceptance to the exchange program.</p> <p>The cost of the visa (SEVIS fee) is currently \$220 USD. Updated fee Information can be found here: <a href="http://www.fmjfee.com">www.fmjfee.com</a></p> <p>Additionally, there is a \$125 SEVIS University Fee students pay every semester at Colorado State University. The fee is charged during the semester to their CSU student account.</p>
<b>Are International students allowed to work?</b>	<p>Yes. There are two options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. On-Campus employment with approval</li> <li>2.
