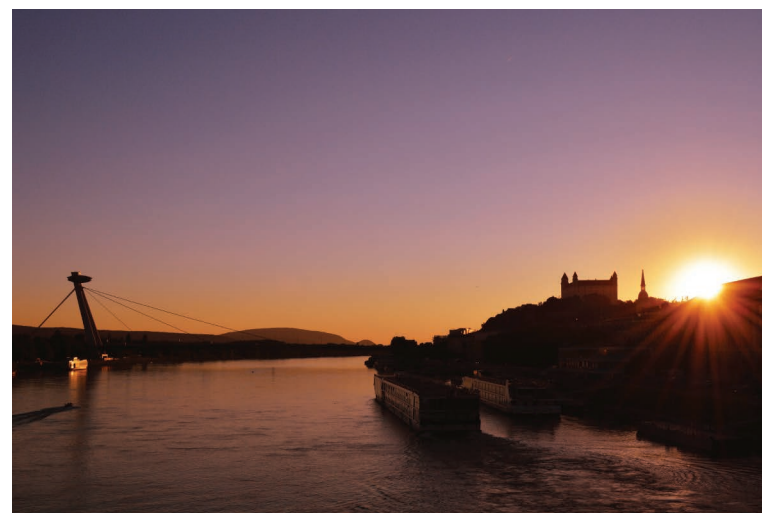


## :: LIVING IN BRATISLAVA

<b>LUNCH IN STUDENT CAFETERIA</b>	€ 3.90 - € 6.00
	Students will get discounts for sports activities.
<b>ESN (ERASMUS STUDENT NETWORK)</b>	ESN organizes various events and trips to explore nearby areas. <a href="https://esn.sk">https://esn.sk</a> , <a href="mailto:euba@esn.sk">euba@esn.sk</a>
<b>PEER SUPPORT</b>	The ESN buddies will contact the Incoming Students and in order to help them upon their arrival (way from the airport, etc.), how to get accustomed to living in Bratislava and to the student life.
<b>ISIC (FEE € 25.00)</b>	For students under 26, applicable for discounts at and outside the University. The ISIC card provides: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• access to restricted areas (University buildings),</li> <li>• FAX Copy, Ticket Portal, and University Library access,</li> <li>• cheaper tickets for bus, tram transportation and for traveling,</li> <li>• discounts when visiting cultural institutions (such as museums and galleries ...).</li> </ul>
<b>UNIVERSITY STUDENT CARD</b>	Usually for those that can not get the ISIC-card. Only applies inside the University.
<b>VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMIT</b>	Non-EU citizens need a residence permit. The requirements may differ according to student's nationalities. Please turn to the Slovak embassies in your home countries.
<b>HEALTH INSURANCE</b>	Students from EU/EEA/Switzerland are entitled to health care and must present <b>EHIC-card</b> . Other students coming within a programme arising from an <b>international treaty</b> shall submit necessary documents certifying his/her study at a higher education institution in the Slovak Republic. Other than those aforementioned options students can take private insurance.
<b>ACCOMMODATION</b>	Erasmus+ students have various possibilities of accommodation. Some of them are as follows: Student House, Mlyny Dormitory, Slovnaft Dormitory, or they can choose an apartment on Airbnb or Flatio. There are many groups on Facebook offering flat renting or websites such as <b>erasmusu.com</b> and the buddy will be more than happy to help the student! The International Mobility Department does not assist with finding private accommodation.
