Immigration

Many non-EU students entering Ireland must show airport officials a valid entry visa. North American students do not require an entry visa but are required to have an offer letter from UL at the entry airport and will be required to register with INIS for the duration of their stay. The immigration registration fee is €300.

Accommodation

On-campus accommodation is available for Study Abroad Students, which ranges from approximately €2,600 to €3,900.

This cost includes Electricity, Gas Heating, TV License, Cable TV, Wi-fi & General Maintenance. Deposit payable of €500.

Modules/ECTS Credits

A normal semester load at the University of Limerick is 24 - 30 ECTS credits per semester (12 - 15 US Credits).
