


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Time is up! Read-only access to Sulis ending now

If your content on Sulis includes BigBlueButton recording links, make sure to copy and save any links you want to keep, as they will no longer be recoverable from Sulis after October 31st.



Vevox has taken off!

Statistics of usage of our new class engagement tool, Vevox, are looking great! By the end of Week 6, over 500 polls had been run with over 10,000 attendees¹, and 220 Q&A messages have seen sent. The largest class a poll was run with was 358 students. 23% of the polls have been run through the integration in PowerPoint, while the rest were run through the app or the BrightSpace integration.



¹ Attendees are not individual students, but each time that a student sat in a session where a Vevox poll was run.


New accessibility tool: Ally



Anthology Ally was launched this semester. This integrated tool on Brightspace encourages staff to design and create more accessible content and embed UDL practices. Ally also allows staff and students to provide Brightspace content in alternative formats, e.g., mp3, ePub and immersive reader. An early adopters' group is currently piloting Ally, and each faculty now has a champion tasked with supporting Ally adoption within their faculty. It is planned that Ally will be available to all staff in early 2025. If you want to learn more, see documentation for Ally in the Brightspace Knowledge Base. Reminder: Imported Turnitin Assignments

When you import assignments with Turnitin enabled from another module, you'll need to manually re-enable Turnitin for the assignments. After the content is imported, you'll see a notification in the Assignments tool area prompting you to re-enable Turnitin. If you don't reenable, Turnitin will not work for submissions, and it cannot be applied retroactively.

- Those starting with Brightspace can visit <u>Brightspace Training</u> for recorded introduction videos and complete <u>Introduction to Brightspace for Instructors (Brightspace 101)</u>, a self-paced course that will guide you through all you need to know to get started, and receive notifications from just in time announcements with user tips and technical updates.
