



# Professional Diploma in Supply Chain Management

## Programme Overview

The Professional Diploma in Supply Chain Management offers learners practical interactive knowledge required to manage today's global supply chains. Gaining theory, current practice and skills to increase supply chain performance within their own organisations.

## Participants will learn to:

- Develop insights and understanding of the inter-relationships and performance outcomes of relevant supply chain.
- Critique the current theory, practices and processes of specific supply chain management topics.
- Engage in critical discussions with fellow learners and identify, determine and discuss international current practice.

## Programme Content

Developed and delivered by industry and academic experts, this programme will run over two academic semesters with a duration of five weeks for each 6 credit module.

Course delivery is through a combination of self-instructional materials and regular webinars and online tutorials. Modules are delivered online via our dedicated online learning management system facilitating a flexible learning environment.

- Strategic Business
- Mathematical/Analytical Modelling in Supply Chains

### Semester 2 - Autumn

- Marketing Technology Products
- Simulation Modelling in Supply Chains

## Further Qualifications

## Entry Requirements

Applicants require a 2.2 degree in a relevant discipline or equivalent and at least five years relevant work experience in a supply chain function.

The recognition of prior learning and prior experiential learning as per University policy will be applied to this course. Candidates who do not meet the minimum entry criteria may be interviewed by the Academic Programme Director.
